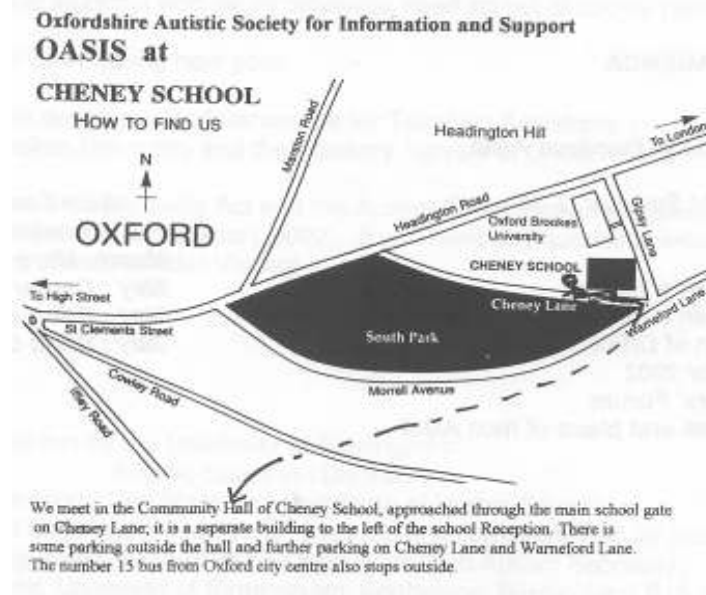

We also offer evening meetings with guest speakers on many relevant subjects that affect those with and living with someone who has Autism.

Sometimes we have organised special events, such as conferences and workshops.

Some members represent OASIS at the meetings of various strategic groups and we try our best to make planners aware of our members' needs and to lobby for better provision for children and young adults with Autism. OASIS also attracts professionals working within the field who can offer their expertise and time.

Our informal coffee & chat groups and have been a great way to meet others in a similar position. We offer a warm friendly welcome, coffee and cake. There is always plenty of conversation, sharing knowledge and experiences.

During the school holidays we hold our popular playdays. These give families an opportunity to meet up as a group and allow children on the spectrum and their siblings to be themselves.

Our evening meetings are held at Community Hall, Cheney School, Cheney Lane, Oxford OX3 7QH in term time (see reverse of leaflet). Our website and mailings for members give details of forthcoming events. These meetings feature coffee and chat time followed by a guest speaker. We try to invite people to speak to the group who can give informative talks on subjects that affect us bringing up children and young adults on the Autistic Spectrum. We also have a good selection of books that you can borrow as a member. The library is available at the Cheney meetings.
